Abstract The pandemic exposes policymakers to fundamental uncertainties about future economic scenarios, while they have to act forcefully to mitigate the impact on the economy. These conditions call for policy strategies that are robust to uncertainty. We compare two concepts of robust strategies: robust control and robust satisficing. We argue that a robust satisficing strategy is preferred.
